NULL values in PATCH method (how does Java actually differentiate?)

When using the http request method PATCH it is necessary to distinguish whether a field was omitted or whether a null value was sent. A construct similar to the JSON PARSE converting phrase for booleans would be useful to specify, what a null should be converted to, e.g. Low-Values or another Value:

```
JSON Parse ZielFeld-UTF8(1:ZW-LAENGE-Ausgabe-JSON)
  Into Display-Example
    Converting Every Numeric When Null To Low-Values
      Every Nonnumeric When Null To 'NULL'
End-JSON
```
